Greenwich Theatre Model

You will need:

- 5 X roughly A4 sized pieces of cardboard (+ Spare for your performers)
- The 6 Printable templates on A4 paper
- Double Sided tape or Blue tack
- PVA Glue or a glue stick
- Paper clips
- Scissors
- Colouring pens or pencils

Anything else you might want to put your own stamp on your Greenwich Theatre I.e. Glitter



Instructions:


Start by putting blue tack on the back of your templates and sticking them onto the cardboard pieces. (this will make it easier for you to cut out)




Getting an adult to help you, cut out each of the templates on the cardboard. You will have the Stage, the three walls and the Proscenium Arch. Then fold all the flaps inward, this helps keep everything together.



Using your glue attach the Stage Right wall to the stage. Remember that this is a theatre, and stage right is actually left if you are looking at the stage as if you were the audience! Stage right and left if based if you are on the stage, looking at the audience.




Then stick the back wall and the stage left wall so you will have the back walls in place. (Top tip, use paperclips to free up hands while the glue is drying)



Now is the perfect time to decorate your proscenium arch, we have decorated ours like our fabulous Pantomime, but you can add your own spin!



Next, getting an adult to help you again, you can cut out your performers, either just from the template, or using the cardboard.



Give them their costumes and make up, then either glue or blueback them to some pencils, to make it easier for you to move them about the stage



Your walls should be dry so you just have to stick your proscenium to the front and let it dry. (Don't forget the paperclip tip)



And that's it! Your Theatre is ready for your actors to tread the boards and put on a show!
